

Directions to Villa Milagro Vineyards from Poconos and North Pennsylvania

From Poconos, take 33 South to I-78 East

On I-78 East

Take the last exit in PA which is **Exit 75 for Easton-Rt.611**. At the top of the **ramp, turn right** and go to the stop light. At the **stop light make a left** onto **Cedarville Road**. This road winds around and down to a “T” intersection. Make a **right onto Rt. 611** South toward Raubsville. Travel 7.5 miles to a stop light (the only one) in to the town of Rieglesville, PA. At the **light, make a left onto Delaware Street**. It will go over a wooden bridge, curve right then left over a bridge over the Delaware River and into New Jersey.

The bridge was designed by Roebling who later designed the Brooklyn Bridge. It recently celebrated it’s 100th birthday!

Just off the bridge the road curves right then left over a railroad track. This is **Rt. 627**. The second mailbox on the left is us. You will see a Farmland Preservation sign, a small sign for Villa Milagro Vineyards and a white **mail-box #33**. Go left up the paved driveway. The pavement ends after about 300 ft and becomes a gravel farm lane. Continue about a mile to the vineyard. You will see the vineyard and vintners’ residence on your right as you wind around.
